OUR 2019 RIGHT BANK EXPRESSION OF CABERNET FRANC IS HYPER CLASSICAL IN STYLE - REFLECTING THE EXCELLENT TERROIR FROM WHICH IT IS CREATED: A VINEYARD SITE IS A BLEND OF GRAVELY LIMESTONE AND CLAY, ALLOWING THE WINE A NON-ACIDIC SOIL ENVIRONMENT AND GIVING THE FINISHED WINE A HIGHER ACID AND STRUCTURE PROFILE. THE CLAY CONTRIBUTES TO REDUCED VIGOR OF THE VINE AND ALLOWS THE VINE TO FOCUS ON PHENOLIC PRODUCTION.

A STUNNING WINE FROM THE SINGLE MOST HISTORIC SITE FROM WHICH WE MAKE WINE. THIS SITE WAS LIKELY PLANTED AS FAR BACK AT THE YEAR A.D. 50 (ALMOST 2,000 YEARS OLD).
